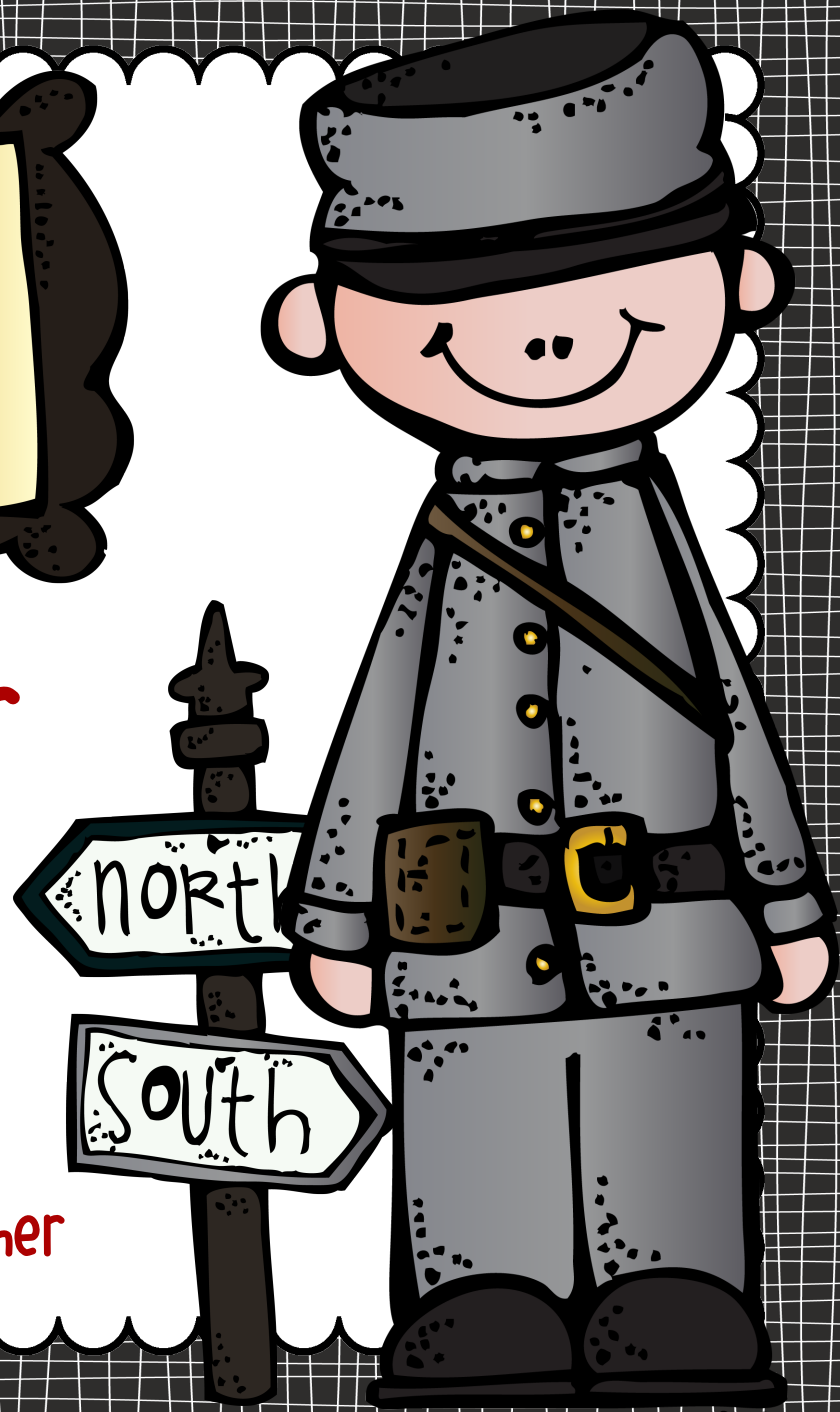

These printables can be used as part of a social studies unit, an informational text unit or a study of biographies. All students can make the same foldable or groups can be assigned to different people.

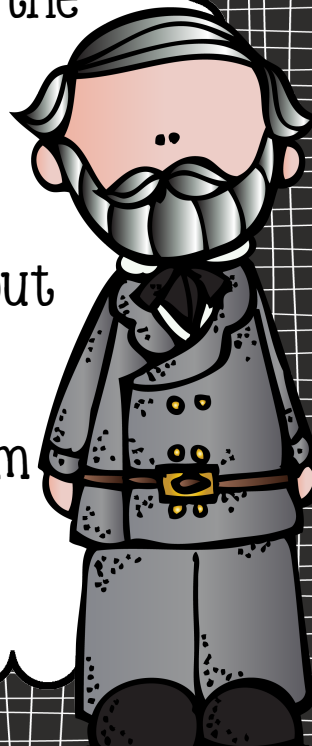
Make copies of the printables for each student.

Have students fold the edges into the middle so that the sides of the bodies meet.

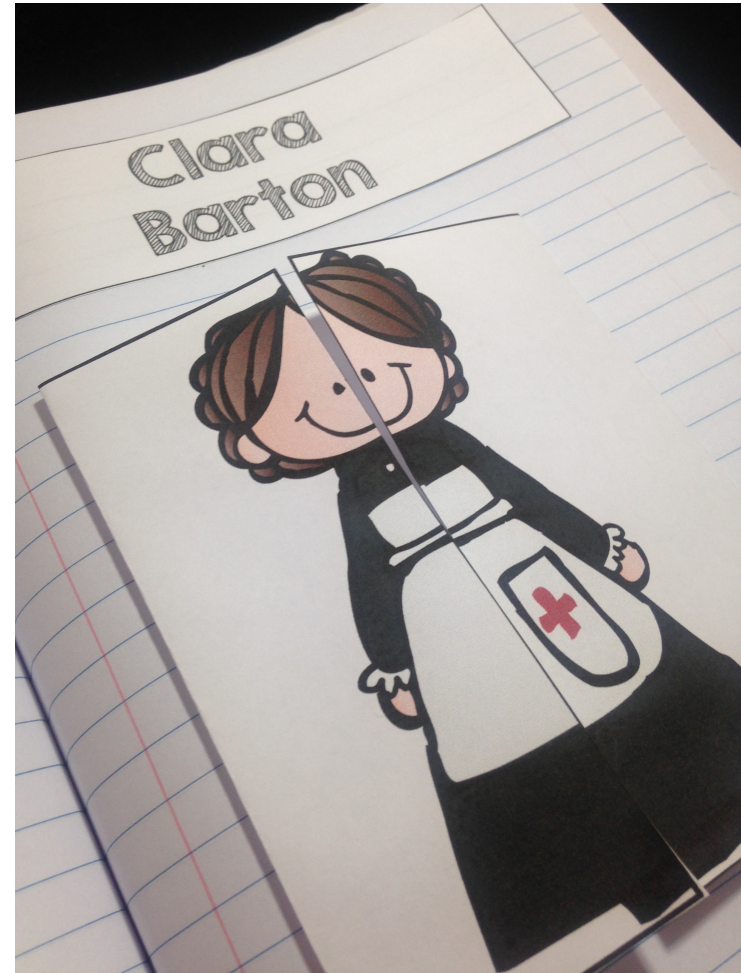
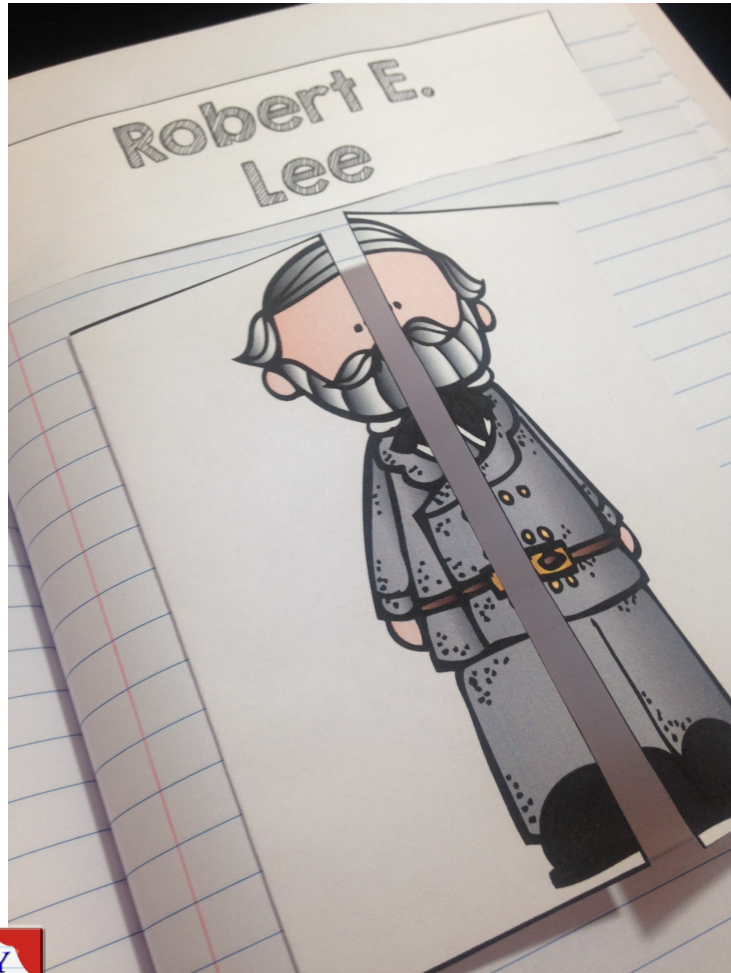
Students can color the person.

Have students do research or use curriculum to write facts about the person inside the foldable.

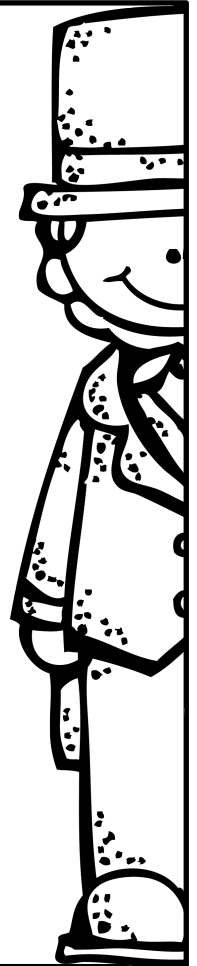
Glue into interactive notebooks. Alternatively, you can glue them to construction paper for a display.



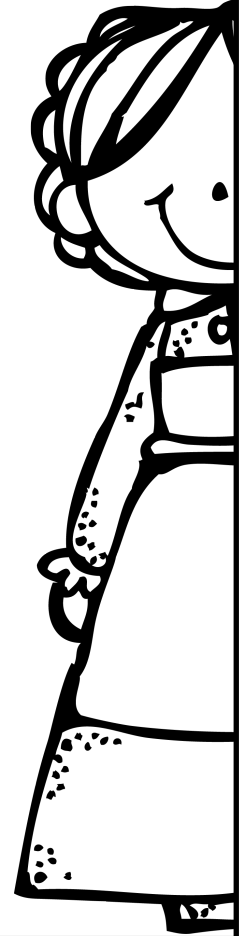
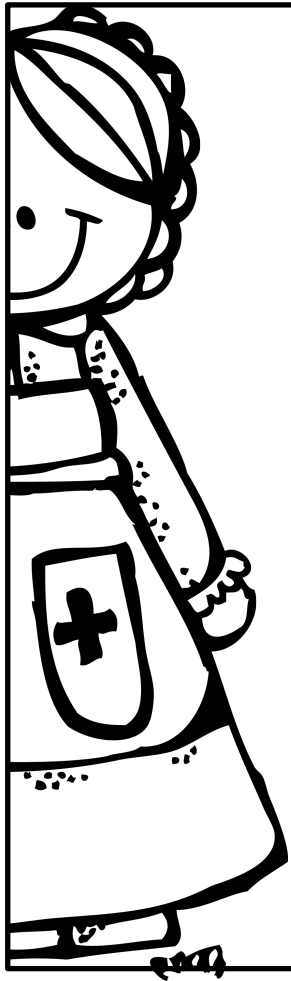
